Role Title:	Pathfinder Community Support Volunteer (PCSV)
BCU/Dept:	Devon & Cornwall (Various Locations)
Hours	Minimum 4 hours per week

Scheme Description

Pathfinder is an out of court disposal designed to identify “critical pathways” and intervene in an offender’s early behaviour in order to reduce or stop further offending and victimisation. The scheme requires the offender to comply with a 4 month bespoke contract. If they re-offend or choose not to engage with the scheme, the normal criminal justice process will resume. In order for an offender to be eligible for the scheme both the victim and offender must provide their consent.

Role Description

- Support Keyworkers with administration and office-based tasks
- Assist with internal website, social media outlets, newsletters and good news stories
- Support offenders with transport, accompanying to meetings and reintegration
- Act as a positive role model
